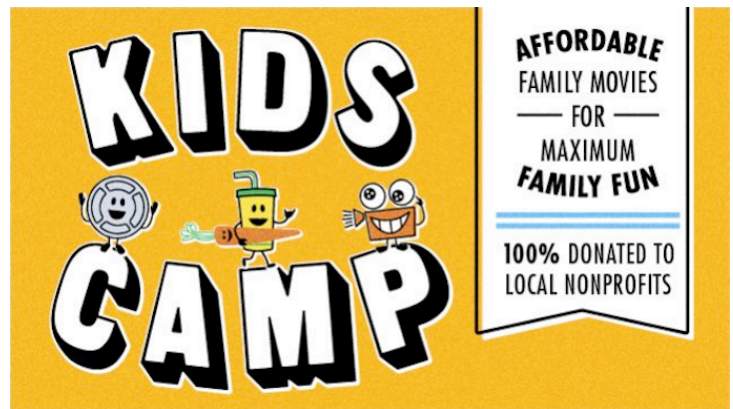

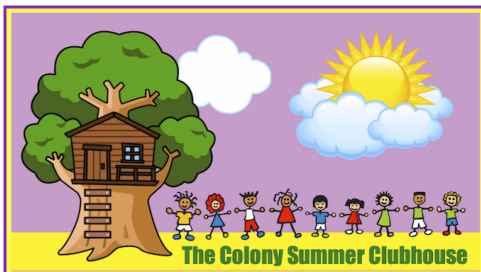

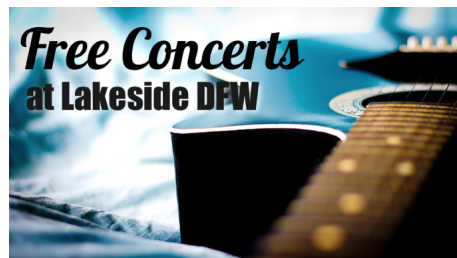

# POOL SAFETY TIPS

## Carrollton Fire Rescue Encourages Pool Safety

As the temperature rises, swimming activities increase, so help keep Carrollton safe throughout the month of May for National Water Safety Month as well as the entire season. The week before Memorial Day (May 23-29) has been designated Healthy and Safe Swimming Week by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and the goal of these efforts is to maximize the health benefits of swimming by minimizing the risk of illness and injury.

Everyone plays a role in preventing injuries and illnesses when it comes to the water we swim, play, and relax in. Water-based physical activity can benefit an individual's health and children can also benefit socially from interacting with other kids in pools.

Aquatic enthusiasts can prevent fatal and nonfatal drownings by learning swimming skills, wearing life vests, and swimming under the close supervision of parents, caregivers, or lifeguards who know cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).

According to the latest CDC statistics, drowning is the leading cause of unintentional death among children ages 1-4 years, the second leading cause among ages 5-14 years, and ranks sixth overall among the leading causes of unintentional death in the United States.

Three children die every day as a result of drowning.

From 2010-2019, there was an annual average of 3,960 fatal unintentional drownings (non-boating related) in the United States – about 11 deaths per day, per CDC data. According to the report, about one in five people who die from drowning are children ages 14 years and younger. For every child who dies from drowning, another eight receive emergency care for nonfatal submersion injuries.

Carrollton Fire Rescue (CFR) encourages parents to watch young children while in the bathtub and to designate a responsible adult to supervise their kids when swimming or playing in or around water. Water watchers for preschoolers should provide “touch supervision” – being close enough to reach the child at all times. Because drowning occurs quickly and quietly, adults should not be involved in any other distracting activities such as reading, being on the phone, or mowing the lawn while supervising children, even if lifeguards are present.

Formal swim lessons can protect young children from drowning. However, even with lessons, constant supervision when children are in the water and barriers, such as pool fencing to prevent unsupervised access, are still important.





# FROM CARROLLTON FIRE RESCUE

Parents and caregivers are also encouraged to learn CPR. The City offers training on the first Saturday of each month at the Carrollton Fire Administration building (1111 W. Belt Line Road, #100). The next scheduled CPR/AED/Basic First Aid course is set for Saturday, June 4 from 9-10:45 a.m. and is \$25 for residents and \$27.50 for non-residents.

One of CFR's goals is for as many citizens as possible to be trained in CPR/AED. Get trained, save a life. Until then, if a collapse of a teen or adult is witnessed, call 911, check and see if they are breathing, and if not immediately begin pushing hard and fast in the center of the collapsed person's chest to the beat of 100 to 120 pushes per minute until emergency medical teams arrive. This simple, hands-only CPR can increase a cardiac arrest victim's chance of survival.
